Letter in Edna's notebook  
Elberton, Ga, Sept -13th 1910

To: Miss Eunice Gideon, Anderson, S.C.

My dear Madam:-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant requesting information concerning your Rampley ancestors, and I have answered it as full a manner as I could on the sheet prepared by yourself. I am unable to give dates of the birth and death of any of my great-grand parents or my grand parents. The information I give you was obtained from my father many years ago. I don't know if the family record kept by father contains any information along this line.

The old family bible belongs to me but it is not at home at present having loaned it to a relative in an adjoining county. When this record is returned If it contains any information that will be beneficial to you I will write to you again (over)

John William Rampley was born and reared in England and came to this country as a British soldier during the revolutionary war. He was very young and belonged to a wealthy family of high standing and who had no other children.

Soon after the elder Rampley landed here as a British soldier he became dissatisfied with his allegiance to the English government and joined the colonial force and fought with them to the close of the war -

After the close of the war he settled in Spartanburg District S.C. where he married Mary Hewett - Four children were born to them, William the youngest being my grandfather and your great grand father -

You will notice I give the names of the children on another sheet - Your grand mother married John Giddins as my father called and spelled the name and I suppose is the only living member of the family - I never saw but two of my father's sisters viz - Aunt Mary Watson and Aunt Bettie Reid and who first married William Darby.

I never saw but one of father's brothers, the youngest James M. who died about three years ago. I lived near him for ten years. His widow Hattie W. Rampley lived many years in S.C. with Uncle Jim and she might give you some information. Carnesville, Franklin Co., Ga., is her post office -

I agree with you about John being a family name. Father had a brother John who died in 1857. I have a brother John who is living in Texas and I have a cousin John Rampley who lives at Carnesville.

I trust you may uncover in some manner the information you so much desire, because I think you are engaged in a laudable undertaking and one that be a pleasure to you in after years should you complete it.

I would be pleased to hear from you again telling me of your progress &c.
