Given under my hand & seal this Fourth day of August 1824

In the Name of god Amen I Thompson Browning being Weak in Body but of Sound and disposing mind Memory and Understanding do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and form following - first I give and bequath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Lee Wife of Robert Lee Twenty five Dollars. Second I give and bequath unto my yongest Set of Children named James, John, Nancy, Clary and Hulda to Receive one Hundred Dollars as they become of Edge (age?). Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my grandson Samuel the son of my son Samuel fifty Dollars. Fourthly my will and desire is that the Balance of my Estate both Rail and personal after Paying all my Just Debts, be Left or kept in the hands of my Loving wife Rebekah during hur natural Life or Widowhood, and at her death or marriage to be either sold, or divided By my Exctrs. (The names Rebekah, Andrew Jesse have a line drawn through them) An equally among all my children my Son Robert, Andrew and Jesse my daughter Elizabeth Lee, Secondly James, John, Nancy, Clary, Hulda - and I do hear by nominate constitute and appoint my loving wife Rebekah, and my Two Sons Andrew and Jesse Exctrs. of this my Last will and Testament hereby Revoking all form or wills by me made in witnis whare of I have her unto set my hand and Seal this 29th day of March - 1824.

I really don't know any thing about Mary Goodwin other than her parents and sisters moved to Gibson Co and Mary Goodwin followed them there with her children. I have gone through two drawers today to try to get them all straight again. I will post something tomorrow on the Lee site. I wonder how many people are really interested in the Brownings. Robert brought it up so I will work with them. I also reread the letters from Deb about her Hogarth. She had done a tremendous amount of research on them and was so thrilled to finally make the break through. She wrote to many of the Jeffery Smith descendants and one knew about the first marriage and child. Nice to hear stories of breakthroughs like that.

While considering the geographical aspects of the community, it is interesting to note one physical feature of the land, which was of great importance to the settlers and to the church soon to be birthed. Oral tradition tells us that at a point on the Second Broad River, where the Henrietta dam is now located, there was an area of rocky shoals in the water, with perhaps one group or possibly even one shoal being larger and higher than the others. It is believed that the High Shoal Baptist Church obtained its name from being located near this shoal.

I'm seeking descendants and information on ANDREW BROWNING of DeKalb Co. Ga. for which the Browning District of DeKalb was named. I'm pretty sure he was the son of THOMPSON BROWNING of Union Co. S.C. but I lack the documentation. Andrew was born around 1790 in S.C. and his wife was ANN H. ___?___(parents unknown). Andrew named a son THOMPSON A. BROWNING and a daughter CAROLINE BROWNING who married ROBERT LITTLE. Their daughter Ann H. Little married my ancestor, George M. Thomas in 1853. I think he had another daughter that married a Goza. He had other children but I don't know who they are. In the 1848 Tax Digest for the Browning District of DeKalb were these Browning names: ANDREW, JESSE, SOLOMAN, HIRAM and THOMPSON. In the marriage records of DeKalb Co. was a marriage of a JOSHUA BROWNING to Lucy Ellis on 17 Sept. 1843. In the minutes of the Old Fellowship Baptist Church in DeKalb were these members: Andrew, Ann, Jesse and CASSA Browning. Could Jesse and Cassa be his children? I would love to contact anyone who has information on any of these Brownings.
