before us the Board of Land Commissioners  
for the County of Westrop, and proved according  
to Law, that the (Capia Stewart) arrived in  
this Country in 1823, that she is the head of  
a family and settled to one Labor of Land  
upon the condition of paying at the rate of  
three dollars and fifty cents for each Labor  
of Irigable Land two dollars and fifty  
cents for each Labor of temporal or arable  
Land, and one dollar and twenty cents  
for each Labor of pasture Land, which  
may be contained in the survey secured  
to him by this Certificate. Given under  
our hands this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April 1838

 tives of Cassia Stewart <sup>situated in Bastrop Co. 11 miles S.E. by S. from the town of Bastrop</sup> west of the Colorado river on the  
 County of Bastrop it being by virtue of certificate No 245  
 for one labor <sup>of land</sup> issued by the board of land for the County  
 commissioners for the County Bastrop. beginning at the S. W  
 corner of a survey of 340 <sup>on the share of C. Tapp</sup> acres a stake from which a post oak mark  
 # 12 inch diameter bears S 42 W 3 varas a blackjack 4 inches diameter  
 marked X bears 96 — thence N 54 8 varas to a stake from which  
 blackjack 12 inches diameter <sup>black</sup> bears W 1 var another marked # 10 inch  
 diameter bears S 10 W 4 varas thence N 18 23 varas <sup>on the S. boundary of league # 12</sup> to a stake from which
