1973, Federal Class, for 36⁶/₁₀ Acres issued
by the Comm^r General Land Office on the 3rd
day of June 1873 to Ann H. Hale, as an
acquired balance upon her certificate No. 16239
issued by Comm^r Gen^l Land Office on 6th day of
July 1870 for 858⁶/₁₀ acres. Situated in Pecos
County on the waters of Pecos creek a tribu-
tary of Sulphur River about 5 miles South of
Pecos. Beginning at a stake A. G. Milton's
N. W. corner on the S. B. Line of a survey in the
name of John P. Peony - Thence South with the
West Line of the aforesaid survey in name of
Milton 420 rods to a stake, the N. E. corner
of a survey in the name of R. Smith -
Thence West with said Smith's N. Line 492 rods
to a stake from which an Elm tree N 15 E 9 rods
and a Pine tree N 19 E 19 rods both marked X
Thence North 420 rods to a stake on the S. B.
Line of the aforesaid survey in name of John
P. Peony, a Red Oak tree S 15 E 8 rods marked X
Thence East along said Peony's Line 402 rods
to the Beginning. Surveyed Dec 3rd 1874
