Thence South with John Neels Survey 2010 vrs to a spring branch  
in all 3300 vrs to a stake S Wilson N West corner from which bears  
a Black oak N 61 E 9 vrs Hickory N 40 W 12 vrs both marked SC  
Thence East 1370 vrs to Wilson N East corner in all 1530 vrs  
to Cane Creek in all 1733 vrs to a stake from which bears  
a Black oak N 28 W 7 vrs Black oak N 83 E 7 vrs both marked SC  
Thence North 1273 vrs to a stake on W<sup>m</sup> Mahon's South boundary line  
from which bears Black gum sapling S 44 W 4.2 vrs Red oak S 9 E 5 vrs both marked SC  
Thence West 280 vrs to S Mahon's S W corner a stake from which bears  
a Linn N 23 E 8 vrs Elm S 71 E 11 vrs both marked SC  
Thence North 1124 vrs to a stake S Mahon's N West corner from which bears  
a Red oak S 62 W 15.3 vrs Post oak S 40 W 23.2 vrs both marked SC  
Thence West 310 vrs to Cane Creek in all 464 vrs to a stake from which  
bears a Red oak N 57 W 4 vrs Black oak N 30 W 11.6 vrs both marked SC  
Thence North 180 vrs to Cane Creek in all 903 vrs to a stake  
the SE corner of Jonathan Collum's labor from which bears  
a Pine N 48 W 12.6 vrs Post oak S 42 W 7.1 vrs both marked SC  
Thence West 535 vrs to Cane Creek in all 1000 vrs to the beginning  
containing 2 labor arable and 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  labor pasture lands.
