that I John White of the County & Republic
aforesaid do by these presents, Nominate Consti-
tute and appoint Joshua J. Gill of the aforesaid
County and Republic; my true & Lawful agent,
and attorney, to Ask, demand, require, & receive
of the General Land Commissioner of the Republic
aforesaid a patent to my head right, issued
in Houston County for Six hundred & forty Acres
of Land N^o 239 and dated 1st January 1840
And the unconditional Certificate issued by the
Board of Land Commissioners for the County of
Harrison: N^o 226 for 640 Acres of Land &
Dated - March 15th 1844 Now these
are therefore to Authorize and empower the
said Joshua J. Gill, or any other agent
or Attorney the said J. J. Gill may choose to
appoint to make said application, to wit,
Ask demand require and receive of the aforesaid
General Land Commissioner, a patent to a party
or all of ~~said~~ my said head Right as it
may hereafter be surveyed and all acts
done and performed by said Gill or his attorney
in the above premises. shall be as legal and
binding in Law as if I had been personally
present and had done the same in my own
proper person and name hereby ratifying and
Confirming all his said acts.
