Public Domain approved Feby. 11th 1858 and an act amen-
datory thereof approved Feby. 1st 1860. Situated in Panola
County on the East side of the Sabine River, on the waters
of Jackson Creek a tributary of the Sabine, and about
13 miles N^{35°}E. from the Town of Carthage. Beginning
522 mrs South of the South East corner of V. P.
Williams survey at one of the N. E corners of the Jef-
ferson Hill survey at a stake from which a red Oak Brs.
N. 68° W. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. and a ditto Brs. N. 77° E. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ mrs.
