Field notes of a survey of 53 1/2 acres  
of land made for John S. White by  
virtue of an act for the sale of the

Public Domain approved Feb. 11<sup>th</sup> 1858 and an act amendatory thereof approved Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> 1860. Situated in Panola County on the East side of the Sabine River, on the waters of Jackson Creek a tributary of the Sabine, and about 13 miles N. E. from the Town of Carthage. Beginning 522 rods South of the South East corner of V. P. Williams survey at one of the N. E. corners of the Jesse M. Hill survey at a stake from which a red Oak Post. N. 68° W. 5 1/10 rods. and a ditto Post. N. 77° E. 3 3/10 rods. Thence North with the West boundary line of said J. S. White's one hundred acres surveyed on land script, & at 475 rods. his N. W. corner, on and at 522 rods. intersected the S. E. corner of V. P. Williams' preemption survey a stake from which a post Oak Post. N. 75° W. 8 1/10 rods. and a ditto Post. N. 64° E. 7 rods. Thence West with said Williams' S. boundary line & at 575 rods. his S. W. corner on J. M. Hill's East boundary a stake from which a pine Post. S. 68° W. 4 rods. Thence South with J. M. Hill's East line 522 rods. another corner of his survey. a stake from which a Pine Post N. 13° E. 16 rods. a red Oak Post. N. 26° E. 8 1/10 rods. Thence East with said J. M. Hill's line 580 rods. to the place of Beginning; containing fifty three & a half acres of land Bearing trees marked J. W. Surveyed Oct 29. 1860
