Thence with said survey N 55° E at 76 varas the SE corner of same a pine marked + br S 87° W 3 7/10 varas. Thence N 35° W with Kennedy line at 115 varas corner on same. 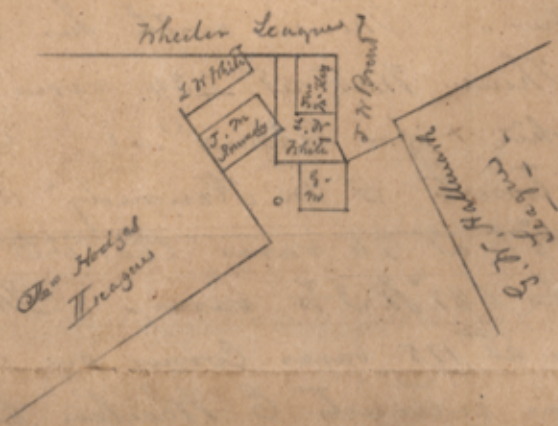

Thence West with Greenberry Mathews N.B.line at - 950 vrs his N.W. corner. Thence South at 10 vrs corner. Thence West at 434 - vrs corner, a White Oak & an Ash mkd. X Thence North at 540 vrs intersects the J.M.Kennedy 240 acre survey. Thence with said survey N 55 E at 78 vrs the S.E. corner of same, a Pine mkd X brs S 87 W 3.8/10 vrs. Thence N 35 W with said Kennedys line at 115 vrs corner two large Pines mkd X . Thence - North at 1342.8/10 vrs set stake for corner. Thence East at 444.2/10 vrs - set stake for corner on J.
