Houston County * Corrected field notes of 320 acres of land, made for H.F.Craddeock, by virtue of Bounty land Warrant, no 3500, issued May 22nd - 1838 to L.W.White for 640 acres of land by B.E.Bee Secretary of War, said survey is no 1080, in Houston County, Texas, situated on the waters of Speer Creek, a tributary of Trinity River, about $6\frac{1}{2}$ miles ^{580±} East of Crockett, - Beginning at the S.W. corner of the J.W.Brent 640 acre survey, a White Oak - brs N 63 W 9.8/10 vrs. Thence West with Greenberry Mathews N.B.line at - 950 vrs his N.W. corner. Thence South at 10 vrs corner. Thence West at 434 - vrs corner, a White Oak & an Ash mkd. X Thence North at 540 vrs intersects the J.M.Kennedy 240 acre survey. Thence with said survey N 55 E at 78 vrs the S.E. corner of same, a Pine mkd X brs S 87 W 3.8/10 vrs. Thence N 35 W with said Kennedys line at 115 vrs corner two large Pines mkd X . Thence - North at 1342.8/10 vrs set stake for corner. Thence East at 444.2/10 vrs - set stake for corner on J.
