Bounty Certificate No. 3498 issued
to Sion Pitchard on the 22nd day of
May 1838 by Barnard E. Bee Secretary
of War for 320 acres of land, for which
this is my file, and asks that you survey
the same, viz Beginning at the South
West corner of a survey in the name of J. B.
Conner on the east line of R R Russells
heath right or Colonists right. Thence in a
southerly direction with said Russells line
one quarter of a mile. Thence in an
easterly direction one half mile. Thence
northerly to said Conner Survey. Thence
westward to place of beginning to con-
tain One hundred and sixteen acres. The
survey to be in an ^{oblong} square form, one
quarter of a mile by one half mile.
