This was a rash endeavor. I was trying to figure out John and William Whites who may have been related to John and Katharine White and their son, Barrett. Since people landed along the coast, I assumed that they moved later, but I didn't check every Parish/County in the are, and of course, Counties divided, so the names change. I didn't name every person, but if they were a John or a William, I tried to provide information about their known relatives, and sometimes I added a name on a whim. Some of this information came from official documents; some information came from books/articles that discussed records. But, some of it was confusing, and so this should be considered to be useful information requiring further investigation.

William White, who was listed as a member of the Committee of Safety for Louisa Co., married Elizabeth Starke White (Barrett White's widow) in 1787 and moved to Hanover County, where he died in 1790, according to the Bible Record of Barrett and Elizabeth and their son, William.
